I will be participating on the Kairos Weekend #41 at Nottoway Correctional Center May  $2^{nd}-5^{th}$ , 2019. I would love for my Church to be a part of this Ministry. No, you don't physically need to go with me, but I need your support in two ways:

Prayer-The foundation of any Ministry is prayer. I would ask that you pray for me, the Kairos Team, the residents of Nottoway, especially the ones God will send to our program for the weekend, as well as the officers and staff of Nottoway Correctional Center. I will place Prayer Partner sign up sheets in the side windows just through the doors on each side of the pulpit of our sanctuary. Please first name and last initial only. (NO LAST NAMES)

Cookies-Each member of our Kairos Team is required to bring 100 dozen cookies to our weekend event. We usually have 25 Men on the team-that's 30,000 cookies. What does that look like-LOVE! Homemade cookies are a tangible expression of Christian Love and serve as an indication of God's concern to a group of people who seldom encounter either in the course of their daily lives. YOUR loving sacrifice will provide the "flame" that will shine the Light of God's Grace into the darkest corners of the prison.

If you would like to help with making cookies, I have the guidelines & recipes for the approved cookies that are allowed into Nottoway Correctional Center. The recipes are simple and easy. Please let me know if you would like to help. I will need the cookies no later than May 1<sup>st</sup>.
