

A NOTE FROM TRACY

It has been a difficult month, hasn't it? Here at FBC we have said goodbye to Alma Lewis and B.A. Klein. In the community, we have lost several others we loved and prayed for. We have continued to navigate the COVID-19 lockdown and the beginnings of re-opening, and the death of George Floyd has thrown the country into unrest as thousands have taken to the streets in calls for justice and systemic reform. It has been a difficult month, indeed.

Through it all, I am grateful for the way you have embodied the gospel and worked to bring about the kingdom of God. Over the last months, we have ministered to our ill and grieving families with meals, prayer cards, letters, and social distancing visits. We have worked hard to stay connected online, and those not online have received delivery of newsletters, bulletins, sermons, and surveys. We have supported Farmville Cares as they have reached out to the most vulnerable in our community; we have supported essential workers, grieving families, and others with drive-by parades. Thank you Farmville Baptist for BEING the church. Our building may be closed, but we are open and at work throughout our community.

The months ahead will be challenging as we continue to navigate the ongoing effects of COVID-19 and seek ways to bring both justice and healing to our brothers and sisters who have suffered the effects of systemic racism for far too long. Both of these situations are complex, and often we feel that there is little we can do to bring about lasting change. However, each voice and each action makes a difference. This week in our daily online devotional time, we have drawn on two passages of Scripture to help us live into this call. The first is Micah 6:8—And what does the Lord require of us but to do justice and to love kindness, and to walk humbly with our God? The second is Matthew 22:36-39 where Jesus reminds us of the greatest commandments: to love the Lord our God with all our hearts, and with all our souls, and with all our minds, and to love our neighbors as ourselves. My prayer is that we will continue to model beloved community and the grace of God to Farmville and beyond as we move forward together.
