Come and join the group that is circling the church in prayer every Sunday. Our greatest hope should be for a Spirit led process from beginning to end.

Soon, the search committee will host round-table discussions focused on visioning, asset mapping and aligning our mission, building use, budget and programming. The insights gained from this discernment process will become a key part of the congregation profile. Every voice is important, so plan to participate fully in these sessions.

Finally, will you join me in committing to the following:

- 1. Trusting that God is actively at work in our midst as we move forward.
- 2. Trusting that the staff, the search committee, the deacons and other key leaders have the best interest of the church at heart and are serving to the best of their abilities. Will we stumble and make occasional missteps? Of course, we are all human. Will we disagree from time to time? Of course, we all have unique perspectives. Will we have questions and concerns along the way? Of course, change always raises these. As we step into this new chapter, may we all commit to working together in a spirit of love and graciousness, sharing our concerns and questions in productive and appropriate ways and supporting those we have called to serve among us.

I am excited for the future of Farmville, and I'm delighted to be on the journey with you.
