Zoom Instructions

If you haven't joined us on Zoom yet, here are the very simple instructions to get started.

If you are logging in via the **internet** follow the below steps.

1. Go to zoom.us.
2. Click on the tab labeled "Join a Meeting".
3. Click the box that says "Meeting ID or Personal Link Name". Type in corresponding meeting ID for either Worship Service, Daily Devotions, or Wednesday Night Sunday School listed below and click "Join".
4. Your computer screen will then alert you "A download should start automatically in a few seconds" and you should see an orange box with an arrow pointing towards a small box in the lower left hand corner of your screen labeled Zoom followed by a string of numbers.
5. Click on this small box and follow the instructions to download the application. At the end of the download, click "Join" to enter the meeting.

If you are calling in via **phone**, you do not need to follow these steps; just simply dial +1 253 215 8782 or +1 301 715 8592 and enter the corresponding meeting ID for either Sunday Worship Service, Daily Devotions, or Wednesday Night Sunday School listed below followed by #.



STEWARDSHIP DURING COVID-19

Closures related to COVID-19 are expected to have a significant financial impact on churches and non-profits. In a recent article, Bill Wilson predicted that many churches will see a 30-50% decrease in giving as people are laid off and increasingly cautious about their spending. In response to this news, the trustees, treasurer, assistant treasurer, and the chair of the personnel committee met with Tracy during the last week of March to discuss ways that FBC can be the best possible stewards of your tithes and offerings during the pandemic. The following measures are now in place, and will be lifted as soon as we are able:

In the building: We have adjusted the HVAC, lights and hot water for maximum utility savings.

Our Staff: Please take a moment to express your appreciation to our staff. Janice Kiehm has concluded her service with us, and the other salaried staff have opted to volunteer their services or take a reduction in salary. We are grateful for the sacrifices they are making during these challenging days.

Meal Options Update During COVID-19 Closure

Prince Edward County Schools will utilize the USDA Summer Food Service Program to provide bagged breakfast and lunch meals during the COVID-19 school closure. Meals will be available to all children up to age 18 regardless of income level. Meals will be served “drive through style” so no need to get out of the car. Any questions feel free to call the middle school cafeteria at 434-315-6111.

There will only be distribution of meals on Tuesday April 7th so our staff can get much needed rest. Bags will have enough meals for seven days. We will begin Tuesday and Thursday only meal pick up the week of April 14th. This is a change from the five days a week, Monday through Friday pick up. Meal service will end on Thursday May 21 at all locations.

Pick up times will be from 10:00 am to 12:00 pm at all six locations.
