### FBC'S REAWAKENING

#### Let's Make this Extraordinary Time

It's a new season—a new liturgical season that is. After Pentecost and Trinity Sunday, we enter the liturgical season known as "Ordinary Time." The term "Ordinary Time" may be misleading. In the context of the liturgical year the term "ordinary" does not mean "usual or average." Ordinary here means "not seasonal." Ordinary Time is that part of the Liturgical Year that lies outside the seasons of Lent-Easter and Advent-Christmas. In Ordinary Time, the Church celebrates the mystery of Christ not in one specific aspect but in all its aspects. The lectionary readings during Ordinary Time help to instruct us on how to live out our Christian faith in our daily lives. The color for ordinary time is green, symbolizing hope and growth.

It is anything but an "ordinary time" here at FBC, but the words hope and growth are appropriate ones to describe our church family these days. We are hopeful as we are finally emerging from the pandemic and opening our building more fully. We have witnessed personal and spiritual growth as we have worked through the challenging Wednesday night curriculum together. There is more growth to come and great hope as we prepare to welcome a new pastor later this year. There is evidence of growth and hope as we congratulate our graduates and bless them on the next phase of their journeys – be it to careers or further schooling.

I am confident that there is continued growth to come as we worship and serve together this summer. In service, some of us packed food with FACES over the Memorial Day weekend. Others will work on the Habitat House in late June (see related article about how to sign up!). Still others of us will help distribute COVID-19 safety kits to vulnerable residents.
