

# A NOTE FROM PASTOR ADAM

#### What's In a Name?

"A good name is more desirable than great riches."

#### Proverbs 22:1

Names are important. They are how we iden fy ourselves to others, they are how we learn something about the world around us, and they are vital components of the social fabric of our world. The name we have helps shape us, and the name we choose to use to iden fy ourselves to the world tells the world something about us.



All of that is as true for the church as it is for an individual.

In worship for the last two Sundays of June and the first Sunday of July, we've been thinking about our name – *Farmville Bap st Church*. We've talked about each component, considering what it tells the world about us and how it calls us to be who we say we are.

**Farmville** – We have chosen to put the name of our town first in our name as a congrega on. This tells the world (and reminds us) that we are *in* and *for* this place, seeking to bless our town and community with the love of God. We do remember, though, that we are not ulmately *of* this place; we remain, and always will remain, a church *of* God.

**Bap** st – We are historically part of the Bap st way of doing church together. That means there are ways we operate that have been handed down to us by the Bap sts before us, but it ul mately means that we are a people of *freedom*. Four freedoms have ma ered significantly to Bap sts through the years – Bible freedom, soul freedom, church freedom, religious freedom – and we connue to celebrate and uphold these freedoms as a Bap st church.

Church – The most important part of our name, the word *church* tells the congrega on and the community that we are a par cular type of organiza on. We are not a club, we are not a social service, we are not a school or an advocacy organiza on; we are a church, and a church is a *colony of heaven*. We are saying our ci zenship is somewhere else, and our values are the values of the kingdom of God. We strive to live those out here, as we live our earthly life and represent the kingdom to the community and world around us.

That name, which we have on our sign out front, on our bulle ns and publica ons, is the name of our church. It is a good name, one to both be proud of and strive to fulfill. And, as the writer of the proverb says, such a name is more desirable than great riches.

May we faithfully live as Farmville Bap st Church



We are six months into 2022 now and I am pleased to report that we are receiving in gifts and offerings pretty close to our year to date expenses. In addition we have some funds in reserve should an unexpected expense pop up. But we have not returned to our giving levels we were experiencing in the pre-covid days of 2020. Also, there are some expenses that occur in the final quarter of each year which will require additional funds. Now is the time for the leadership to revisit our stewardship plan.

Summer time traditionally is a season of lower worship attendance and thus lower offerings received, so each gift will be quickly put to good use.

We have always promoted "equal sacrifice" at FBC. That means for everyone to give at a level that is appropriate for their annual income. Give as you can is another way to call it. I am asking each of you to prayerfully ask yourself what gifts you can provide the Church, financial or otherwise, and together we can grow this ministry in Farmville and beyond.
